On December 2, 1980—four US women (including Jean Donovan and Ursuline Sister Dorothy Kazel of Cleveland) paid with their lives for their decision to stay in solidarity with poor, marginalized victims of violence in El Salvador. Our organization was founded to honor their witness and carry forward their legacy of solidarity. Since 1981, we have been promoting peace and justice in Central America by engaging Ohioans in education and action.
