Dear Sirs:

We, members of the InterReligious Taskforce on Central America, are concerned for the safety of **Pascuala Gutierrez Alvarez** as she is at risk of torture or ill-treatment. A Tzetal indigenous woman, she was arrested without a warrant for an alleged kidnap on 8 April in San Cristobal de las Casas, Chiapas State. She is being detained without charge in a safe house (casa de arraigo o seguridad) at the Prosecutor's Office (Fiscalia General de Justicia del Estado).

Casas de arraigo undermine the fundamental rights of persons in detention, encourage the use of coercion and violate fair trial guarantees.

## We urge you to:

- Take precautions so that she is not subject to torture, ill-treatment or coercion while in pre-charge detention;
- Allow her full access to her family, lawyer and medical attention, if necessary;
- Charge her with a recognizably criminal offense or release her;
- if she is to be charged, provide due process and fair trail standards
- investigate the legality of her detention and subsequent pre-charge detention;
- end the use of arraigo (pre-charge detention);
- reform legislation to ensure that constitutional guarantees restricting the time period suspects may be held without charge are upheld.
