Dear Sirs:

We are saddened and outraged that an army-backed paramilitary group killed **Héctor Díaz Serrano**, a member of the oil workers' union (USO), on his way to work on March 2 in the city of Barrancabermeja, Santander Department. Amnesty International believes that all trade unionists and other social activists in Barrancabermeja are in grave danger.

That morning the newspaper *Vanguardia Liberal* reported that the Magdalena Medio Regional Command paramilitary group had threatened to kill trade unionists and other social activists running for Congress, including members of USO, CUT (Trade Union Congress), ASTDEMP (Association of Departmental Workers), USITRAS (Santander Workers' Trade Union), and the Metropolitan Coordinating Body for Displaced Persons. The paramilitary group stated: '...we will continue with this fight until we have eliminated the last guerrilla terrorist and their auxiliaries."

## Because of these serious threats, we strongly urge you to

- provide safety measures (according to their wishes) for members of USITRAS, CUT, USO and ASTDEMP trade unions, and the Coordinación Metropolitana de Desplazados,
- conduct a full and impartial investigation into the killing of Héctor Díaz Serrano, publish the results and bring those responsible to justice;
- take decisive action to confront and dismantle paramilitary groups operating in the region and break their links with the security forces, in line with repeated UN recommendations.
