Dear Sirs:

We are extremely concerned about the damage and trauma caused by an explosive device placed in the entry of **School of Arts and Human Development "Mario Gonzalez"** in the municipality of Piedecuesta in the metropolitan area of Bucaramanga, Santander Department on October 12 at 4:30 a.m. For the past three years, the school has worked with low-income campesinos, students, women, youth, and children of the surrounding rural and urban areas, providing them with a space for friendship and solidarity as well as such skill-building activities as gardening, weaving, singing, poetry, dance, and drama. It is affiliated with the Movement of Christians for Peace, the Coalition of Social Movements, the Women's Social Movement and the Secular Franciscans.

The explosion caused structural damage to the café theater Kussihuayra located within the school and greatly traumatized those living close to the school. Neighbors saw two unknown men running toward the area of the central cemetery after installing the device.

## We strongly urge you to

- immediate conduct an investigation into the explosion at School of Arts and Human Development "Mario Gonzalez," make the results known and bring those responsible to justice.
- take all necessary measures in accordance with international and Colombia law to protect the persons and organizations associated with the school.
