Dear Sirs:

We are outraged at the murder of **Edgar Martínez Ruiz**, a mining community leader in San Pablo, Department of Bolivar, who was assassinated on April 24. He participated in various human rights forums calling the San Pablo municipal government to fiscal accountability. A local human rights organization, ACNUR–PDPMM (Defensoría del Pueblo Regional Magdalena Medio y Programa de Desarrollo y Paz del Magdalena Medio), has called for an investigation into the assassination. On June 16, death threats were placed under the doors of their office.

Since January there has been increased violence from the paramilitary forces who have controlled the San Pablo area since the late 1990s. In addition to the assassination of Edgar Martínez Ruiz, there have been twelve other murders this year.

## Therefore we strongly urge that you

- Conduct a prompt and thorough investigation into the assassination of Edgar Martinez Ruiz and the others killed this year, publish the results, and bring those responsible to justice;
- Investigate the recent death threats made against human rights organizations.
