Dear Sirs:

We are extremely concerned for the lives of university students and human rights activists in Barranquilla, Atlántico Department, who have recently received death threats. They are law students Henry Molina, Victoria Cañas; law graduates Edwin García, Yulisa Pereira; philosophy students Fernando Martes, Claudia López; sociology students Carlos Julio Escobar, Nevis Niño; economy students Carlos de la Hoz, Jhoan Mendoza; engineering student James Padilla; and human rights activist Maria Cedeño.

Not only have these individuals been threatened, but a "war" against student organizations has been declared by a group that claims to be a re-armed wing of United Self-Defense Forces of Colombia (AUC), the largest paramilitary organization in Colombia. The students are being falsely identified as members of the two largest insurgent groups in Colombia: Revolutionary Armed Forces of Colombia/People's Army (FARC/EP) and the National Liberation Army (ELN). Some of the students have been displaced to other cities for their security, thus forcing them to end their studies.

We strongly urge that you:

- provide protection for the individuals named above;
- thoroughly investigate the threats and arrest the perpetrators;
- prohibit paramilitary groups from access to the campus of the University of the Atlantic in Barranquilla.
