Dear Sirs:

We are very concerned about an attempted attack and threats to **Benjamin Sánchez**, a peasant farmer in El Carpintero, Cabuyaro Municipality in Meta Department. On January 15 while he was working on his land, an armed man whose face was covered, called his name and started shooting at him. Benjamin Sánchez was not hit by the shots because he managed to hide. The day before, another man working with him saw an armed man following Benjamin Sánchez. On October 27, 2013, Benjamin Sánchez also received a threatening phone call which said: "You are a snitch, that is why the business of El Carpintero is damaged, there is a revolver over your head."

Under the terms of the Victims and Land Restitution Law that went into effect at the beginning of 2012, some of those who were forcibly displaced from El Carpintero by paramilitary groups have sought restitution of their lands. Paramilitaries and agro-industrial companies have an economic interest in the land that the families are claiming. As a result, some families campaigning for their land restitution have been threatened. On July 10, 2012, **Edwin Alcides Duran Peña**, the son of a leader in the community, was killed.

We therefore strongly urge that you

- provide safety measures to Benjamin Sánchez and the families claiming land restitution in El Carpintero, in strict accordance with their wishes;
- order full and impartial investigations into the attempted attack on Benjamin Sánchez's life, the killing of Edwin Alcides Duran Peña and other threats to El Carpintero community members, publish the results and bring those responsible to justice.
